





CAMP JORDAN

Mini-Camp check-in is from 2:00–3:00 PM on Sunday. Check-out is at 1:30 PM on Wednesday.



TIER EXPLANATION

Tier pricing is not income-based, but is based on what your family is comfortable with paying. TIER1- Most accurately accounts for the true cost of operating camp—including wear and tear on equipment, transportation, and depreciation.

TIER 2 – A partially subsidized rate for those who can afford to pay more than just the basic costs associated with attending camp.

TIER 3 – This is an adjusted fee. It covers just the basic costs associated with attending camp such as food, staff salaries, and supplies.

All campers receive the same camp experience regardless of the tier their family pays.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IS AVAILABLE

Families who are unable to afford Tier 3 may download a financial assistance application at campjordan.org. Applications will be accepted until May 17, 2024.
